

Aero-Dienst Vienna Appointed Falcon Authorized Service Center

Located at Vienna International Airport, the 5,500 square-foot facility is equipped to provide line maintenance services for both local and transient operators. It is ISO 9001:2008 Quality Management System certified, has EASA Part 145 and FAA Part 145 approval, and also holds certificates from many other National Airworthiness Authorities, including those in Bermuda, Canada, Cayman Islands, Nigeria, Russia-CIS, Turkey and Ukraine.

Along with maintenance services, the Vienna operation offers 24/7 AOG (Aircraft On Ground) support, including GoTeam dispatch, along with appropriate tooling and equipment. It can also handle repair and overhaul, retrofits, modifications and upgrades.
